

WHAT IS FLOCK?

- A surveillance technology company that operates a nationwide network of AI-powered automated license plate reader cameras.
- 100,000 automated license plate readers are already in more than 6,000 U.S. cities and towns.
- Major funders of Flock are right-wing billionaires Peter Thiel and Marc Andreessen.

A PATTERN OF DISHONESTY AND ABUSE

- Flock has lied about sharing local community data with ICE.
- Local police departments are sharing Flock data with ICE, and using it to track immigrants, activists, women who have had abortions, and ex-partners.
- There is little evidence that Flock cameras reduce crime or keep communities safe.

WE CAN FIGHT BACK

- Everyday citizens have successfully pressured over 70 cities to cancel or reject Flock contracts or deactivate cameras. **We can protect our community too.**



HOW TO GET FLOCK OUT OF YOUR COMMUNITY

- Find out if Flock or other AI-powered license plate readers are in your town. Deflock.org has a crowdsourced map showing exact camera locations.
- Meet with, call, and email local decision makers like the mayor and city council to ask them to cancel your city's Flock contract.
- Attend a city council meeting and share your concerns during public comment.
- Submit a public records request. Every state has its own version of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) that will detail how you can obtain local records. A records request takes minutes to send and could reveal details of how your data is being searched for immigration purposes.

Educate your friends, family, and neighbors about the dangers of Flock and encourage them to contact local decision makers. There's strength in numbers!
