HOW GUTTING CHECKS AND BALANCES HARMS FLORIDA

Project 2025 is a 900+ page plan created for Donald Trump by his political allies and supporters, led by the Heritage Foundation. **He's already implementing it by nominating many people who wrote it to powerful positions in government.**

Project 2025 will have a *devastating impact on Florida*:

TAXES

- An average family of four in Florida would see **a tax increase of \$2,587/year** while multimillionaires would get an average tax cut of \$1.5 million.

CHILD CARE

- The elimination of Head Start would take away free childcare for 44,980 children.

PUBLIC EDUCATION

- It would eliminate the U.S. Department of Education and Title I funding for schools that serve low-income students. **Florida would lose 13,300 teaching positions** that serve 243,931 students.

REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM

- **2,990,000 women would lose guaranteed access to free emergency contraception.**
- Using the Comstock Act to criminalize the mailing of abortion medications, abortion would effectively be banned nationwide, even in states where it is legal.
- It orders the Department of Justice to charge local officials if they refuse to bring cases against women and doctors who violate Florida's strict abortion ban.

STUDENT LOANS

- It would change the way student loan repayment plans work, making 475,800 borrowers in the SAVE Plan pay \$2,700-\$4,100 more a year.

HEALTH CARE

- 1,252,200 Medicaid participants could lose coverage due to new limits on benefits.
- Changes to Medicare would **raise the cost of prescription drugs for up to 1,479,230 people** and would prevent the government from negotiating lower prices.

SOCIAL SECURITY

- In other proposals, Project 2025's authors suggest raising the retirement age from 67 to 69, which would impact 69% of Floridians. This would cut Social Security benefits by \$4,100-\$8,900 after just one year and **retirees could lose \$46,000-\$100,000 over 10 years.**

Project 2025 will hurt all of us and it goes against what most Americans want for our country. The best way to fight it is to stay informed and share this information with everyone we know.
