
We help new local groups across the country get started and existing groups grow and strengthen.







#### **GENERAL TIPS**

- No RWB, TroubleNation, or SWEEP (but variations of "Trouble" welcome!)
- Be intentional: You can change your group's name on your TroubleNation home page as often as you'd like, but your group URL will never change.
- Keep it non-partisan: broadens your appeal

- Relational organizing is *proven* to be far more effective than talking to strangers.
- Red Wine & Blue used this free tool in 2022 and 2023 to help users organize and track their outreach to friends and family.
- Result: 10% increase in voter turnout among users' contacts, and a 7.3% increase among the users themselves!


