## Discussion Questions

- 1. The Best We Could Do opens with a timeline of the history of Việt Nam, focusing on the period of war from 1945 to 1975. Why do you think the author chose to preface the book with a timeline?
- 2. In the preface, Bui notes that this book originally began as a project of transcribing her family's "oral histories." What is lost & what is gained by transforming an oral history into a written one? How does she use imagery to convey part of the story?
- 3. Over the course of the book, there is only one moment when Bui incorporates real photos (of her family at a UN refugee camp in Malaysia). Why do you think she chose to use real photos here?
