■ **MOST EFFECTIVE WAY TO COMBAT FEDERAL THREATS**

- You can't always stop a harmful federal policy in Washington — but you can elect state legislators who will fight to block or mitigate its impact here in Pennsylvania.
- Real protection for our communities starts at the state level. Whether it's safeguarding reproductive rights, protecting LGBTQ+ Pennsylvanians, or ensuring fair elections, the State House and Senate shape what freedom looks like in our daily lives.

■ **ALL YOUR POWER IS LOCAL**

- Change doesn't just happen in D.C. It happens in Harrisburg. And it starts with who we send there.
- Congress may be out of reach, but your state representatives aren't.
- A handful of calls or conversations can shift how a legislator votes on critical issues — from education funding to environmental protection to gun safety.

■ **OPPORTUNITY RICH ENVIRONMENT**

- In 2026, all 203 State House seats and half of the State Senate seats will be on the ballot. That's hundreds of opportunities to elect leaders who actually represent Pennsylvania's values.

■ **BUILDS YEAR-ROUND LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE**

- The Christian Right has expertly used institutions like megachurches, the NRA, and social clubs to organize since the 80s. They've been building local power for decades.
- At RWB, we organize locally all year long — recruiting candidates, mobilizing volunteers, and creating lasting civic infrastructure that doesn't disappear after Election Day.

■ **REDUCES POLARIZATION**

- State and local politics bring people together around shared interests — fixing roads, funding schools,
- keeping health care accessible.
