What Was Harris' Message?

What was Harris' message?

- "Nimble, Relentless, Joyful"
- The Prosecutor vs The Felon
 - "Trump is unhinged, unstable, a petty tyrant"
 - "He will be a dictator on day one"
- "Momala" Family Values
- Justice for women and children
 - Took on transnational gangs as a district attorney
 - Protection of abortion rights
- Affordable housing and supporting healthcare workers



What Was Trump's Message?

What was Trump's Message

- "Make America Great Again" "Make America Healthy Again"
- "Never Surrender" Retribution against enemies
- Tough on immigration
- Bringing down costs "Eggs prices" "Trump Low Prices, Kamala High Price"
- "No forever wars"



More than just an October surprise

War in Ukraine

- Sending aid to Ukraine via weapons
- War that started "on Biden's watch"
- Trump team managed to turn that into a rebuke on the dems calling them warmongers

Trump's assasination attempt in Butler, PA

- Image alone was powerful
- Compared him to one the toughest presidents who survived an assasination - Theodore Roosevelt
- Gained him a lot of sympathy and street cred



Biden Choosing Harris

- No matter what Harris could have done she was seen as a continuation of Biden
- Many voters did not like the fact that there was no primary for her
- Biden's age
- "Clearly, I am not Joe Biden" debate moment



3 month-long campaign vs a 4 year-long campaign

- Trump never stopped campaigning after he lost
- People did not have enough time to learn who Kamala was

Misinformation

- Dems always on the defensive
- Made sure Republicans were in constant control of the narrative

Relational Organizing!

- Talk with your friends, family, neighbors, community members
 - "Don't talk politics" rule should not exist
 - Lonely people, people separated from society are more susceptible to extreme ideologies. We need to fill in those cracks
