

- Creates "safe" districts and predictable election outcomes
- Predictable outcomes create unresponsive elected officials
- Gerrymandering creates disengaged voters
- The **primary** become the important contest
- Competitive primaries benefit extreme candidates
- Extreme candidates who cannot compromise lead to dysfunctional government

In May 2018, Ohio voters approved new rules for congressional mapmaking. The new rules in the Ohio Constitution include rules for keeping political subdivisions together and greater transparency in mapmaking plus a prohibition on gerrymandering.

**Ohio Redistricting Timeline 2021-2023** 


# "You're not listening to me!"





- In 2018, Ohio voters approved new rules for congressional mapmaking that prohibit gerrymandering and require more transparent mapmaking. These rules are in the Ohio Constitution.
- The Ohio Redistricting Commission (governor, auditor, sec. of state plus legislative appointees) defied the Ohio Supreme Court in 2022 which determined that the gerrymandered maps were unconstitutional.
- Congressional maps created in 2022 were not bipartisan, so, were only used for 2022 & 2024 elections.







# We need to keep up the pressure!

Legislative leaders sold voters on the reforms already in the Ohio Constitution. Together, we can remind them to live up to their obligations to transparent


mapmaking and fair voting maps.

### There are rules in the Ohio Constitution...

The makeup of the state's highest court has changed. The court is now heavily dominated by conservatives (6-1). In 2022, the current Chief Justice Sharon Kennedy and Justices Pat Fischer and Pat Dewine supported maps found to be unconstitutional by the majority.

**But a very different Ohio Supreme Court!** 







### What about a referendum?


- At least 6% of the last gubernatorial vote <u>248,092</u>
- 3% of the last gubernatorial vote from 44/88 counties
- The petitions must be filed with the Secretary of State within **90 days after the law or section of law** was filed with the Secretary of State by the Governor.

In 2012, the state legislature repealed a House Bill 194 and Ohioans collected enough signatures to get ar referendum on the ballot.





# In 2011, Ohio Democrats attempted to referendum the congressional map. This led to a "compromise."


