We are a coalition fighting for fair school funding for all Ohio students. Uniting parents, teachers, community members all over Ohio together for our schools!








THE OHIO CONSTITUTION

The General Assembly shall make such provisions, by taxation, or otherwise, as, with the income arising from the school trust fund, will secure **a thorough and efficient system of common schools throughout the state**; but no religious or other sect, or sects, shall ever have any exclusive right to, or control of, any part of the school finds of this state.

OUR PROBLEM





- For a long time, lawmakers didn't follow the constitution. The Ohio Supreme Court said so FOUR TIMES!
- Ohio school funding relies heavily on property taxes - disadvantaging communities with low property values – disproportionately harming Black & brown districts, rural areas, people with low incomes.
- Amid rising property values, voters are fatigued. Half of school levies failed last fall.
- Huffman & his allies have expanded vouchers, costing \$1 Billion and want to do more.



OUR SOLUTION

Fully Fund the Fair School Funding Plan:

- No more guesswork: Requires the state to fund the schools based on the actual cost of educating children.
- Targets dollars where they're needed:
 The plan helps all kids, but prioritizes the most in need like disadvantaged communities and kids with special needs.
- Provides local relief: Reduces the need for local levies.





DeWine State Budget

 Gov. DeWine's budget cuts public school funding by \$103 million – \$95 million in cuts to special ed.

 It included phasing in the fair school funding, but did not update the base costs.

 No updates for special needs, disadvantaged students, English Language learners.







BUDGET 101

- Governor introduces budget framework to spend state revenue (our tax dollars) January 31st
- They have BILLIONS, and it must be balanced.
- Feb mid March: House sessions
- **April early June:** Senate sessions
- June Conference committee reconciles the two versions of the bill
- Full floor vote by June 30th




